Position: Lift Operator

Position Summary: At the general cargo terminal, the lift operator will operate and maintain assigned equipment on the dock, and in the barge and vessels, performing tasks as required, while keeping an accurate log report and assisting crew with other duties.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Responsible for the safe operation of assigned equipment (primarily forklifts, man lifts, loaders) in areas such as the dock, vessels, and barges
- Insures the maintenance of all assigned equipment including performing pre-job inspections and periodic maintenance
- Acts as signal man for other lift drivers, and ship's gear operators
- Assists in dock, barge, vessel and warehouse transloading operations when necessary
- Complete daily inspection reports and forwards to maintenance as needed
- Responsible for conducting quality inspections of various cargoes
- Responsible for recording production information and documenting materials
- Transload cargo to and vessel and barge by marks and count
- Report ALL incidents through company's reporting protocol
- Support company safety initiatives

EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 1 year of heavy equipment experience in a maritime/ industrial environment (preferred).

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Incumbent will work in all weather conditions ranging from warm/hot-cool/cold as well as occasional rain. Will work at different elevations, noise levels will be moderate-high. Job site will contain light to heavy equipment vehicles, small to large equipment, materials, communication equipment, and tools.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The physical nature of the work will vary from day to day based on operational needs; however, the job will require the incumbent to be able to perform: climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, typing, grasping, feeling, talking, hearing, seeing, and repetitive motion. Incumbent will also be required to wear personal protective equipment (PPE) including, but not limited to: Hard Hat, eyewear, safety vests, gloves, masks/ respirators (when necessary) and steel-toe boots. Very Heavy Work: Exerting more than 100 lbs. of force occasionally, and/ or more than 50 lbs. frequently, and/ or more than 20 lbs. of force constantly to move objects.
